Reporting Misconduct by Instructional Personnel and Administrators

All employees have an obligation to report misconduct by instructional personnel and school administrators which affects the health, safety, or welfare of a student. Examples of misconduct include:

- obscene language
- drug and alcohol use
- disparaging comments
- prejudice or bigotry
- sexual innuendo
- cheating or testing violations
- physical aggression
- accepting or offering favors
